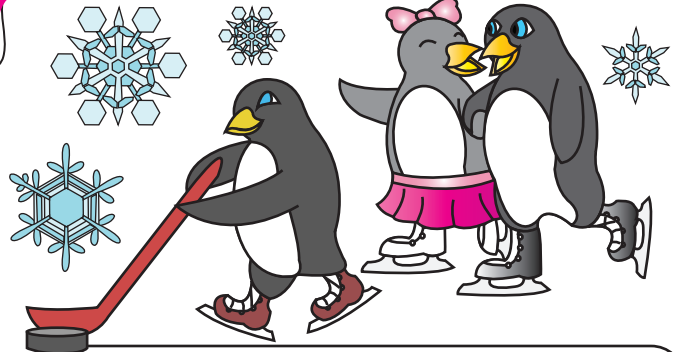
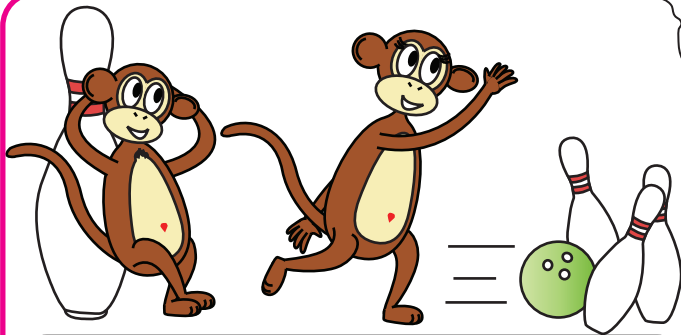


## Working Inside Your Budget!

*Planning A Get-Together!*

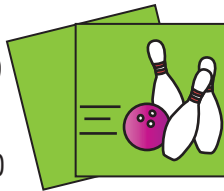
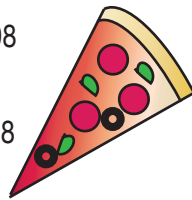


We're having a bowling party for 10 people! Our budget is \$85.48. Our goal is to buy the items that will add up exactly to our budget.
